


UNIVERSITI MALAYA ACTION PLAN ON SINGLE-USE PLASTICS AND DISPOSABLE ITEMS REDUCTION

This action plan is designed to align with the Universiti Malaya Sustainability Policy 2021-2030 and serves as a guiding framework for our campus to reach its objectives of reducing single-use plastics and disposable items.





- Conduct assessments to identify specific categories and prioritize them by phases.
- Engage with key stakeholders in campus.
- Establish measurable goals that align with our sustainability objectives and targets.



Manifesting and Implementing

- Create designated plasticfree zones by phase around the campus.
- Install clear signage and color-coded bins.
- Provide water refill stations, and introduce compostable containers as eco-friendly choices.



Enforcement and Monitoring

- Enforcement via policy/circular and close monitoring by respective entities in UM.
- Ensure all the stakeholders follow this policy in an earnest manner.

Long Term Sustainable Plan

 Integrate these principles into our university's vision, mission and core values.



'Single-use plastic' is defined as all products made wholly or partly of plastic, which are intended for single use and / or for a short period of time before being disposed of.

'Disposable items' are defined as any items other than those made of single-use plastic, intended for single use and / or a short period of time before being disposed of.



- Comprehensive campuswide awareness campaign.
- Multifaceted approach aims to raise awareness for active participations.
- Promote UM Green Event Guideline to enculturate a more sustainable and responsible event in UM.



Collaboration and Partnership

- Establish guidelines to vendors and suppliers.
- Prioritize partnership and collaborate with suppliers to eliminate single-use plastic and disposable items.
- Gradually transition from plastic straws, utensils, and bags to biodegradable, compostable, or reusable alternatives.

This action plan will be reviewed every 2 years, or as required, in order to ensure that the strategies and terms are current, fair and representative of relevant conditions
